- 3. Be set in the future or have the future as theme;
- 4. Be Subtitled in English or Italian (for example with dotsub);
- 5. The film director must be over 18
- 6. Be submitted by midnight 25th February 2018
- 7. Fulfill the application form at the link <u>flash forward form</u>

The short film needs to be sent as a Vimeo or Youtube link to **flashforward.isff@gmail.com**.

Participants are advised that by submitting their link they agree to one free public screening of their short film during the festival. There will be no charge due for submission or screening.

We invite the film directors to attend the festival. Unfortunately, there is no support for travel expenses but the organization can connect guests with students who are willing to host them during the event.
