KloosterKino is not a competition festival, but aims to show the best animated shorts to a small audience in an intimate setting. We are open to submissions throughout the year. Submission Guidelines:

- KloosterKino accepts worldwide submissions of short animations made for the cinema, television or internet.
- Animations should preferably not be older than two years at the date of submission.
- Animations should have a maximum length of 30 minutes.
- KloosterKino does not accept: commercials, music videos, excerpts, unfinished work, etc. Submitted films should be to stand on their own (i.e. not require familiarity with prior work, etc.)
- All KloosterKino films are screened digitally on professional equipment. Films can only be submitted as an HD digital file.
- All films are selected by the KloosterKino organizers.
- Selected films will be screened once for an audience of around fifty people.
- KloosterKino is a non-profit festival and, on the whole, does not pay screening fees.
- Submissions should preferably be accompanied by a press document and at least two hires stills.
