About the Competition

The International Short Film Competition and Award Ceremony on Education Policy aims to highlight the critical role of educational policies in shaping societies worldwide. This initiative seeks to harness the power of filmmaking to provoke thought, inspire change, and foster dialogue on innovative approaches to educational policy reform, challenges, and successes across different cultures and contexts.

Theme for competition: **Education: Challenges and Innovations in Education**

Your submission can either highlight the regulatory challenges in the Education sector or draw attention to any innovative educational practices transforming lives. You can also submit a story that captures both the regulatory challenges and innovations.

Background

Started in 2015, EduDoc is an annual international short film competition that brings the stories of education to life. The goal is to draw attention to the existing challenges, innovations and solutions through the medium of short films and videos. EduDoc aims to identify and document the socio-political, cultural and regulatory challenges in the education system through the audiovisual medium and bring forth the inventive solutions devised by individuals, groups, communities or organizations across the world.

3. Submissions must include English subtitles, regardless of the language used.
4. The deadline for submissions is October 31, 2024.
