RULES & TERMS

The Knoxville Film & Music Festival is now accepting film submissions in the following categories: Features, Narratives, Documentary, Animation and Music Videos.

Films submitted with a musical influence will receive extra consideration.

The winner of the Best of Fest Award will win \$1000 in addition to filmmaking goods and services. The Best of TN Film will be awarded \$500. Every effort will be made to offer housing and accommodations to filmmakers accepted into the festival.

Judges for the festival are world class filmmakers, animators and industry professionals, many of whom will be in attendance. More Oscar than indie this is a festival you will not want to miss.

All contemporary films will be considered for the "Best in the Fest" award. Only competition films will be considered for Best Narrative Short, Best Documentary Short, Best Music Video, Best Animated Short and Best Student prizes.

Films directed, written or produced by residents of Tennessee are eligible to be entered in the Best of Tennessee Showcase category.

Deadline: Submissions in all categories (except Knoxville 24 Hour Film Festival) must be received no later than March 15, 2014. Late entry deadline is extended to May 1, 2014 with an increase in entry fees. The KFMF reserves the right to determine eligibility of any work submitted.

Notification: Films selected for screening at the festival will be notified no later than May 21, 2014. Please do not contact the KFMF to inquire about submission disposition.

Payment: All entries must be pre-paid by credit card or accompanied by a money order payable to KNOXVILLE FILMS for the full submission fee [please see submission fee schedule in listing]. Multiple submissions require separate payments: please do not combine fees into one check or money order.
