



MOSTAR FILM FESTIVAL 2015. – FESTIVAL REGULATIONS

1. Mostar Film Festival (Bosnia and Herzegovina) is project of the C-Centar and its main task is to promote new directions and diversity of the World Cinematography.

2. Professional categories of the festival: Feature fiction movies (more than 50 minutes in length), Short fiction movies (duration up to 30 min), Animated film

3. The festival will take place in Mostar (Bosnia and Herzegovina) from May, 27th to 30th 2015. Film applications must be submitted by March, 1st 2015.

4. Films must meet the following criteria: All films must have subtitles in English; Film must be completed 24 months before the start of the festival; It is forbidden to promote racism, pornography or any form of discrimination.

Selectors have the right to reject film due to poor quality of the submitted film copy which may cause problems during the screenings on the festival.

5. Application should be submitted online on the webpages: www.mostarfilmfestival.com, or www.clickforfestivals.com. After application has been recorded, you will be contacted by our staff with further instructions. When you receive confirmation of the festival, you will need to provide us with film copy or download link (PAL, NTSC), press material in digital form, directors biography, text with information about the production of the film, dialogue list in English and contact details of the person who would present film at the festival.

All selected authors will be notified with invitation letter about participation by April 10th 2015.

6. The maximum number of film screenings on the festival is two. All films will be subtitled into official languages of Bosnia and Herzegovina and English.

Festival will not pay screening fees for film that have been submitted during the Open Call.

7. Copies of selected films must arrive by April 30th. 2015 at the address specified in the invitation letter.

8. Best films will be awarded in the following categories: International Jury Award for best feature film, International Jury Award for best short film, International Jury Award for best animated film, Press Award for Best film, Human Rights Award, Audience Award for best film at the festival in all categories.

9. Representatives, whose films are selected for the official programme of the festival will be invited to be our guests. The festival provides all the necessary accreditations.

10. Other requests that are not regulated by this document will be considered by festivals management in accordance with the general rules of business.
