

Rules & Terms

- 1) Upon submission of a project, the user certifies that all materials submitted to Friday Night Experimental is his or her own work, and that all other information provided, is true and factual.
- 2) If film is selected for participation, the organisers are allowed to extract material from any parts of the film for publicity purposes (i.e images for posters and scene clips, if required).
- 3) Friday Night Experimental will take reasonable care to protect all information received, but in the event of information theft, the organisation is void of responsibilities, related profits, expenses and liabilities arising from the incident.
- 4) Friday Night Experimental will take reasonable care to protect all materials received. However, in the event where similar or identical materials, in terms of idea, plot, theme or other elements, have been created by the organisation staff members, the organisation and its staff are void of responsibilities and the obligation to compensate. Similar or identical materials are purely coincidental and have been independently created.
- 5) Friday Night Experimental reserves the right to organise the presentation of materials in any order.
- 6) In case of any unforeseen circumstances, the festival committee reserves the right to change the dates of the festival.
- 7) You agree to indemnify and hold Friday Night Experimental harmless, from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees, and costs of the court) which may be incurred by reason of any claim involving copyright, trademark, credits, publicity, screening, and loss of or damage to the screening videos entered.
- 8) By submitting your film to Friday Night Experimental the individual or corporation submitting the film hereby warrants that it is authorized to commit the film for screening, and understands and accepts these requirements, rules and regulations.
