The 7th edition of Malatya International Film Festival will be held between 4-10 November, 2016 in Malatya, located in breathtaking Eastern Anatolian Region of Turkey. Some of the finest films of Turkish and World cinema will be screened during a weeklong festival.

Established in 2010, Malatya International Film Festival is held in Malatya which is one of the oldest cities in Anatolia and hosted many civilizations and cultures throughout history. In three years, the Festival gained a great success and became one of the important film festivals in Turkey. The Festival includes an International and a National Feature Film Competition, as well as a National Short Film Competition.

The festival screens approximately 140 films each year, awarding the Best Films with Crystal Apricot as the city is renowned for its apricot. The Best National and International Films are also awarded with 12.500 Euro monetary award. Alongside it's diverse film program, the Festival also includes Q&A sessions, workshops, panel discussions and exhibitions drawing great interest from the audience.
