

SUBMISSION INFORMATION: GLOBAL ECO FILM FESTIVAL 2017

FESTIVAL'S FOCUS

The Festival's competitions include film inspired to science (all disciplines), environment or nature.

DATES

- The 1st Global Eco Film Festival will take place in Zurich between 23 and 24 September 2017.
- The deadline for all applications is May 31st 2017.

CRITERIA

- All films finished after January 1st 2015 are eligible for entry.
- Films can be of any discipline, length, and format as long as they fit into one of the listed categories. A category has to be indicated for each submitted entry.
- Films in all languages are accepted. English and German subtitles, if they are not the languages of the film, are highly recommended.

FILM CATEGORIES

Films will be screened in the following categories (all international):

- Full-length Documentary & Feature Film (50 minutes or more)
- Short Film (feature, documentary, animation and musical videos) (up to 25 minutes)

Clarifications about the categories

- Science: includes all scientific disciplines
- Environment and Nature: include Sustainability, Conservation, Awareness, Ethics, Wildlife, Human-Wildlife Conflict, Urban Wildlife Ecology, Environmental Politics, Bio-diversity, Climate Change, Pollution, Eco-tourism, Eco-health, Eco-food, Eco-terrorism, Eco-disaster...etc.

Customs charges will not be covered by the Festival. Submitted materials will not be returned; all the DVD's received will be kept in the Festival's archive.

FILMS ADMITTED TO THE FESTIVAL

- All entries will be viewed by our programming team.
- The selection process will be completed by June 15th 2017.
- The application to the Festival automatically implies the authorization that a max of 3 minutes of an extract of the film may possibly be broadcasted for promotional use only. (10% of the length for the short films).

COSTS

Submissions are free of charge. The shipping costs of all materials entered are to be covered by the entrants. The Film Festival does not pay screening fees.

AWARD

- A professional jury, consisting of filmmakers, ecologists and scientists, will evaluate the films and determine the winners of each category.
- The Global Eco Film Festival winning films of each category will be awarded with a "Walking Ibex". The "Walking Ibex" imitates Alberto Giacometti's style in the iconic sculpture "Walking Man; L'Homme qui marche I".
