15th ATHENS ANIMFEST 2020 – Rules and Terms

Categories for Entry

Athens Animfest welcomes only short (short, student, experimental, greek) animated films.

Conditions for Entry

The following screening formats are eligible for inclusion: H.264

Technical Requirements:

- File extension: .mp4
- Video Codec: H.264
- Video Frame Rate: 24, 25, 29.97 or 30 fps
- Aspect ratio: we accept any aspect ratio
- Resolution: 1280 x 720, 1920 x 1080
- Field Dominance: Progressive
- Audio: AAC 48 kHz

To be eligible for the short film competition, films must have been completed since 1 January 2018 and be 30 minutes or less in duration.

Non-English language films

The official languages of the festival are English and Greek.

To qualify for selection, all non-English language films must have an English-subtitled screening copy available.

Submission Info

The submission of films may proceed in three ways:

- 2. External submission platform Filmfreeway
- 3. External submission platform Click for festivals

Promotion

The entrant agrees that up to 30" of their film, stills and film info may be used by the festival in promotional activities including screening a clip on television and on the festival's website.

- 1. Entering a film implies the acceptance of these regulations.
- 2. When submitting to Athens Animfest, you are agreeing to screen the submitted film during the dates of the festival.
- 3. You may not re-submit a project that was part of the official selection of a previous edition of the festival.
- 4. By submitting a film to Athens Animfest, the submitter represents that he or she has obtained the necessary consent from any and all owners, creators, writers, producers and/or other authorized representatives of the film and has agreed to the terms.
- 5. Upon completion of the festival selection process, organizing committee will contact the submitter using the contact information provided on the submission form to notify him/her of the film's acceptance status. Athens Animfest will not be held responsible for any failure to contact the submitter using the contact information provided on the submission form. It is responsibility of the submitter to ensure that the contact information provided on the submission form is correct.
- 6. Athens Animfest is under no obligation to provide to the submitter or any other representative of the film any comments or feedback regarding the submitted film.
- 7. Athens Animfest does not pay screening fees for submitted films.
- 8. Athens Animfest has the right to add, alter, change, or delete any portion of the guidelines at anytime without notice.
